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Introduction

Since 2014 Future Proof Health has supported primary care in Dudley and the wider Black Country. We remain wholly owned by General Practice and are IGSoC and CQC approved. Our Board is made up of GPs and Practice managers.

We believe strongly that continued professional development is essential to maintain an up-to-date knowledge and a first-class service for patients. In Dudley Future Proof Health has operated the CEPN (Community Education Provider Network) which later transformed into the Dudley Training Hub. We have from inception provided both face to face courses and online courses and educational events. With the onset of Covid 19 we transferred all educational services to online. We look forward to resuming face to face services in a safe environment soon.

Over the last 3 years we have provided more than 5,350 places for education sessions for primary care in Dudley and the wider Black Country. We have monitored the quality and value of our educational services and we regularly review feedback from our services. We are delighted that this has been consistently positive with courses rated very highly by attendees.

Future Proof Health has been able to support the PCNs in their ongoing development. We have provided education and supported the PCNs with services and employment of staff required for effective PCN operation. We also worked in the Covid 19 vaccination programme and arranged bespoke training for all Black Country staff to support this.

We are an award-winning service winning the NHSX national award for our Oximetry at home service whilst we were running a dedicated COVID-19 Red Centre during the pandemic. We have also won Dudley Integrated Health & Social Care Trusts innovation team of the year for our work in providing the Extended Access Service. We were also awarded the freedom the Dudley Borough by the Lord Mayor. In addition to this we have been nominated for two additional national awards for our work in the Extended Access Hub service.

Our focus remains the support of primary care and education in providing the best possible care for the patients at the centre of all we strive to achieve.
